Introduction  Eligibility	<ol> <li>The ISOC Elections Committee (Committee) was appointed during the ISOC Kenya Chapter (ISOC Ke) meeting on February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 to oversee elections for the Executive Committee.</li> <li>Members who meet the following criteria are eligible to vote         <ul> <li>Be a registered member of the Internet Society (ISOC global)</li> <li>Be affiliated to the ISOC Kenya Chapter</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
	<ul><li>c) Ordinarily reside in Kenya</li><li>d) NOT be a member of the ISOC Elections Committee</li></ul>
Voter Registration	<ol> <li>Members may register as voters by sending an email to isoc_ke_electioncommittee@googlegroups.com on or before 12: oo noon of Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2014.</li> <li>The email should include the following:         <ul> <li>a) Name of the member</li> <li>b) ID or passport number</li> <li>c) Physical address</li> <li>d) Phone number</li> <li>e) Global ISOC number</li> <li>f) Date of registration to ISOC Ke Chapter</li> <li>g) A statement to the effect that information submitted by the voter is true to the best of their knowledge and is submitted in good faith.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Members should note that the email address and phone number provided will be used for official communications including sending of the ballot from the Elections Committee.</li> </ol>
