

VOTER REGISTRATION FOR ISOC KENYA CHAPTER 2014 ELECTIONS

Introduction	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The ISOC Elections Committee (Committee) was appointed during the ISOC Kenya Chapter (ISOC Ke) meeting on February 22nd, 2014 to oversee elections for the Executive Committee.
Eligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Members who meet the following criteria are eligible to vote <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Be a registered member of the Internet Society (ISOC global) b) Be affiliated to the ISOC Kenya Chapter c) Ordinarily reside in Kenya d) NOT be a member of the ISOC Elections Committee
Voter Registration	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Members may register as voters by sending an email to isoc_ke_electioncommittee@googlegroups.com on or before 12: 00 noon of Sunday 16th March 2014. 4. The email should include the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Name of the member b) ID or passport number c) Physical address d) Phone number e) Global ISOC number f) Date of registration to ISOC Ke Chapter g) A statement to the effect that information submitted by the voter is true to the best of their knowledge and is submitted in good faith. 5. Members should note that the email address and phone number provided will be used for official communications including sending of the ballot from the Elections Committee.
Complaints	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. The Elections Committee will consider all voter registration requests. Members who have requested registration but do not receive a ballot or who face any difficulty should send complaints to the Committee at the earliest opportunity.
