Here's the scenario.


Essentially, I have one system running in 3 different banks. The system allows customers to query various items by SMS.

Each bank will therefore require a phone number to give their customers.

The provider will then route the messages to the appropriate bank system, and the bank system will send a response.

See the diagram below for clarity.

For obvious reasons, it is possible for a client to have accounts with multiple banks.



The provider needs to offer the following

- 1. HTTP API to send messages to clients
- 2. HTTP API to send delivery status of messages
- 3. HTTP API to receive messages from client
- 4. Ability to filter traffic by site (i.e. each bank for billing purposes)

- 5. Monthly reports
- 6. A SLA agreement
